A. ELIGIBILITY

1. The applicant must be a high school senior attending one of these schools:
 - Argus High School
 - Central Valley High School
 - Ceres High School
 - Endeavor High School
 - Whitmore Charter High School
2. All applicants must have applied to and/or been accepted for enrollment as a full-time undergraduate student at an accredited college or vocational school in the United States. Documentation of full-time enrollment is required before the scholarship payment is made.
3. All applicants must demonstrate “*Service Above Self*” through a history of school and/or community service.

B. PROCEDURES

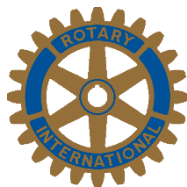
1. **Applications must be received by 4:00 p.m. on March 31, 2017.**
2. Required documents:
 - a. Copy of the applicant’s most recent high school transcript
 - b. One (1) letter of recommendation attesting to the applicant’s character and community service.
3. This \$1,000.00 scholarship can be used for tuition or textbooks, and receipts must be provided as verification of payment. The scholarship will be paid in two installments: fall and spring.
